  - o Communicate with co-members
  - o Be on time to meetings
  - Come prepared for meetings
  - o Follow the meeting's agenda
  - Stay for entire meeting
  - Complete any assigned tasks
- Attend safety council meetings that are usually held at noon on the second Thursday of the month at A Learning Place.
  - o Prepare for the meeting
  - Assist other steering committee members by distributing name tags, completing meeting evaluation, delivering leftover food, etc.
  - o Arrive a little early to greet members
  - o Assist the speaker if necessary
  - Sit amongst the members
  - Be prepared to ask speaker questions
