

Edison State Community College invites qualified candidates to apply for the full time position of Nursing Faculty Member. Full-time faculty are those persons employed to provide instruction during a regular academic year whose assigned load is a minimum of thirty (30) semester contract hours on a 9-month contract (178 duty days). The duties and responsibilities of each faculty member shall include teaching and effective advisement of students; service to the College, including participation in appropriate non-classroom teaching functions and performance of assigned administrative obligations; and on-going professional development and profession service. In order to fulfill these duties and responsibilities, each faculty member shall be familiar with the philosophy and objectives of the College, and, in carrying out these duties and responsibilities, each faculty member shall work within the plans and policies of the college. Two (2) years' clinical experience.
